



Summary of findings

- ✓ Monty's squamous ulcers have improved since the last check-up, which is great progress.
- ⚠ Some ulceration remains on the lesser curvature of his stomach, so treatment needs to continue.
- ✓ His glandular stomach area is almost completely normal, with only two very small inflamed spots.

Today's gastroscopy showed that Monty is on the right track! The ulcers in his stomach are healing, but they aren't fully resolved yet. We need to continue his treatment to ensure he heals completely. His overall physical exam was normal, showing he is otherwise in good health.



Medication and feeding schedule

Current Medications (Continue for 1 month)

- 💉 GastroGard (omeprazole): 1 tube by mouth once daily.
- 💉 Sucralfate: 10g by mouth (via syringe) twice daily.

Daily Administration Routine

- ☀ **Morning:** Give GastroGard first thing.
- 🕒 Wait 45 minutes.
- 💉 Administer morning dose of Sucralfate.
- 🕒 Wait 45 minutes before morning feed.
- 🌙 **Evening:** Administer evening dose of Sucralfate.
- 🕒 Wait 45 minutes before evening feed.



Supplement and diet changes

- 🧪 **Switch Supplements:** Transition from Purina Outlast to Relyne GI or Protek GI. Relyne GI is preferred as it's easier to use and helps coat the stomach lining.
- 🌿 **Pre-Exercise Hay:** To protect his stomach, feed grass hay 45 minutes before exercise. Soaked alfalfa is also an option.



Next steps

- 🔗 **Continue Treatment:** Follow the medication and feeding plan for one more month.
- 📄 **GastroGard Supply:** We will submit a request for an additional month of GastroGard for you through BI's satisfaction guarantee program.
- 🏥 **Recheck Appointment:** Schedule a follow-up gastroscopy in one month to confirm the ulcers have fully healed.
